HOW TO REGISTER YOUR CHILD, OUR PROTOCOLS, EXPECTATIONS AND GIFT

- **Fill out the registration form completely, return to our office via email:** aida.hamont@gmail.com or **mailing address:** 188 Dalewood Crescent, Hamilton, ON L8S 4C1
- A non-refundable deposit of \$50 is required to reserve your child's spot and will be deducted from the camp fee. The balance of camp fee is to be paid in full by June 15th, 2023, unless you are signing up for multiple weeks and a payment arrangement will be made.
- E-transfer is our preferred method of payment. An automatic deposit has been set up for our email. Please ensure you include in the message **"YOUR CHILD'S FULL NAME"** and **"Week or Weeks Attending."** Cheques are also accepted to: AiDa/K. Sherman sent to our mailing address.
- An email confirmation of your child's week will be sent. IF you have flexibility in weeks that work best please let us know by first and second choice. IF YOU REQUIRE certain weeks, please let us know. We will try the best to accommodate.
- **CANCELATION POLICY:** If you cancel for any reason while camp is in session, NO REFUNDS will be issued as space has been designated for your child. If camp is cancelled due to COVID, Act of Nature or Camp Director a refund will be made for days affected. If you have paid fees in full before June 1st, 2023 and have to cancel, written notice must be received **prior to June 1st, 2023** and a refund will be issued (*minus the \$50 non-refundable deposit for holding space and \$30 administration fee*).
